Jemison, first black woman to travel into space as mission specialist
Julian, invented synthetic cortisone
Bath, discovered and invented a new device and technique for cataract surgery known as laserphaco
Williams, first African American doctor in the world to perform a successful open-heart surgery
Easley, developed and implemented code used in researching energy-conversion systems
Banneker, built America's first home grown clock out of wood
Crumpler, first Black woman to earn a medical degree in the United States
Hayden, witness who testified to the chemical identification of Krebiozen
Greene, the invention of a latex based pressure sensitive adhesive for coating conventional substrates to form an adhesive tape
Moore, the first Black woman at Michigan to earn a BS and MS in Electrical Engineering
Collins, discovered a new species of termite called *Neotermes luykxi*
Cobb, discovered that methotrexate was effective in the treatment of certain skin cancers, lung cancers, and childhood leukemia
Newman, the invention of a durable hairbrush with synthetic bristles.
Griffin, taught amputee veterans to write with their teeth and their feet
Carruthers, principal designer of a telescope that went to the moon as part of NASA's Apollo 16 mission
Vaughan, NASA's first black manager
McNair, America's second black astronaut
Drew, african american doctor who invented blood plasma
Woods, invention of the Synchronous Multiplex Railway Telegraph
Branson, discovering the Alpha Helix
Thomas, developed a procedure used to treat blue baby syndrome
Clark, first African-American woman to earn a master's degree in Engineering Management from Vanderbilt University
Brown, first African American woman surgeon in the South
Goode, invented a folding cabinet bed to fit in small homes
